1. **Why Pray to God?**
A powerful pattern for praying is found in The Lord's Prayer, as recorded in Matthew chapter 6. This tract addresses various aspects and benefits of prayer. It encourages readers to connect with God, then develop their prayer life.
2. **Why Answer Jesus' Call?**
This tract looks at what Revelation 3:20 means when it says "Jesus is knocking at the door of our hearts." It explains God's marvelous salvation and grace, and what it means to answer God's call.
3. **From Gangs to God's Glory**
This tract contains a letter of encouragement from an incarcerated ex-gang leader to a 13-year-old boy. William survived a murder attempt by his own gang, met Jesus Christ, and now lives for God's glory.
4. **Why Answer Jesus' Call?**
Many believers and unbelievers struggle with the issue of forgiveness. This tract looks at God's forgiveness of us, the grace He gives us to forgive others, and the blessings that will follow.
5. **Why Become Born Again?**
This tract explains Jesus' revelation that we must be born again in order to see God's kingdom. It looks at the miracle of salvation by God's grace, inviting readers to receive Christ and eternal blessings.
6. **Why Follow God's Path?**
This testimony tract traces the life of a young woman who, after 28 years of drug use, acknowledged God's loving patience and received Christ's forgiveness. Sherry now seeks to walk down His path instead of her own.
7. **Why Focus on the Lord?**
This tract tells the story of Lisa, who became a Christian as a child. While inside a women's prison, she learned that her Savior not only sets people free from drug addictions, but He will help them live as victorious Christians (free from relapses) if they keep their focus on Him.
8. **Being a Good Person Couldn't Get Me Into Heaven**
Growing up as a minister's daughter, Marilyn thought she was a "good person" destined for heaven. After becoming born again, she realized she had been on the wide road leading to destruction.
9. **A Transformed Life (an allegory)**
In this story, Frisco the frog witnesses to Theodore the tadpole, who finally takes a leap of faith and is transformed into a "new creation." Becoming a born-again Christian is not about adopting a religious belief system. A spiritual dynamic occurs when the Holy Spirit comes to dwell within!
